RULES & TIPS for a pleasant trip

● **Keep Watch**

Your group must be supervised at all times while on the train or waiting for the train.

● **Be On Time**

Arrive at all departure locations at least 30 minutes before scheduled departure. Trains and buses do not wait for late arriving groups or individuals.

● **Listen Up**

Listen carefully to station and train announcements or you might miss important information that will affect your group.

● **Be Courteous**

Please be respectful of other passengers. Do not harass or impose on them in any way. Treat all train personnel in a dignified manner.

● **Let Us Know You're Here**

Prior to boarding, identify your group to the conductor and follow his/her seating instructions. Please have ticket readily available to present to the conductor.

● **Stick Together**

Make sure that your group remains in the designated seating area and does not sit in other sections of the train.

● **Restrooms**

Children must be accompanied by an adult to the restroom area. One person at a time is permitted in the restroom.

● **Keep Clear**

Avoid crowding aisles, stairwells, and passageways between cars.

● **Quiet Please**

Personal music devices are not allowed, unless used with earphones or headsets.

● **Snack Time**

Bring your own food and drinks, or take your group to the Café Car. Only 5 persons from your group are permitted in the Café Car at any one time and MUST be accompanied by an adult. Food brought onto the train is not allowed in the Café Car. Attendant in Café Car cannot heat up or prepare food brought on board.

● **Keep Clean**

Please use the trash receptacles and keep the area around your group clean and free of debris. Also throughout the train are bins for recyclable items. If you are unsure where the trash or recycle bins are located, ask the conductor. Please make sure you have all your belonging and have cleared your area of trash when you leave.

● **We're Here to Help**

During your trip, feel free to contact the conductor or other onboard personnel for help.

● **You Have Arrived**

When exiting the train, follow the conductor's instructions. Two chaperones should follow behind the group and check the group's area for anything that may have been left behind. Capitol Corridor is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
