- No one contracted firm is guaranteed any amount of work
- Sum total of all contracts not to exceed \$10M



Three Scores:

- Planning
- System Operations
- Engineering Design

Scoring is done up to 3X and in two steps

Step One: Written Score	 Project Team Qualifications – 25% of total score Experience of the Firms – 25% of total score Approximately top six written scores added will move on to oral score
Step Two: Oral Score	 Only top six from written scores Presentation & Question/Answer Interview Scores – 50% of total score
Total Score:	• Written + Oral Score
