- To determine their willingness to travel once SIP is lifted


Survey Period: May 18 – May 27, 2020

- posted on social media channels


Number of Respondents – 410 Average Time - Three Minutes

Q1: Have you continued riding the Capitol Corridor for essential travel during the Shelter-in-Place orders?






Q2: Prior to the SIP orders, how often did you ride the train?






Q5: When you resume riding the train, will it be for:

Q6: How often do you anticipate riding the Capitol Corridor once the SIP orders have been lifted?








